

Dear Parents and Future 3rd Grade Students!

*We look forward to a great new school year this August. To get the year off to a good start, **please bring the following supplies to class on the first day of school.** Please make sure that you follow the specific requirements of the list below. Thank You!*

- **3-RING BINDER** – 2” wide (not smaller). Make sure it is a regular plain binder with hard covers and pockets on the inside front and back covers. Do not buy any fancy kind with soft, padded covers, Velcro or zippers. Definitely no trapper keepers.
- **SUBJECT DIVIDERS** – 1 pack. Please label 6 of the dividers with the following subjects: Math, Reading, Writing, Vocabulary, Social Studies, Science.
- **PENCILS** – 72 sharpened #2 pencils with erasers at the ends.
- **RED BALLPOINT PENS** – 2 pens for correcting work
- **GLUE STICKS** – 3 large, white
- **FELT TIP MARKERS** – 2 sets, 1 set of fine point and 1 set broad tip. Make sure there are at least 8 colors in each pack.
- **CRAYOLA CRAYONS** – box of 24 colors
- **COLORED PENCILS** – box of 12 colors
- **ERASERS** – 5 to 10 pencil top erasers and 2 separate large white erasers
- **HIGHLIGHTERS** – 3 different colors
- **POST-IT NOTES** – 1 pad of 3” x 3” size
- **PENCIL HOLDER / POUCHES** – must be the soft pouch style that closes with a zipper. The zippered pouch must be large enough to hold a few pencils, the red pens, erasers, and the highlighter. Please do not bring boxes or hard plastic containers
- **KLEENEX** – 1 large box
- **SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS** – 2 notebooks: 1 green cover, 1 yellow cover
- **3 SUBJECT SPIRAL NOTEBOOK** – 1 notebook with purple cover
- **FLASH DRIVE** – 2GB flash drive for students to save their own work and projects in the computer lab.
- **STUDENTS WHOSE LAST NAME STARTS WITH THE LETTER A – M:**
1 ream or package of white regular copy paper
- **STUDENTS WHOSE LAST NAME STARTS WITH THE LETTER N – Z:** 1 ream or package of “pastels” assorted colors or “bright” colors copy paper (NOT cardstock)-**Please make sure the packet has different colors.**

Students should have the following items to use at home for homework assignments or projects: box of crayons, extra pencils, a ruler (showing inches and centimeters), a glue stick, and scissors.
