Depending on their schedules, students may not need everything listed below, and some materials not included on this list may be needed.

In addition to this list, all students are recommended to have an **agenda or planner**. A spiralbound agenda commonly used by many HM middle school students will be available for purchase in the Husky Student Store when school begins.

#### <u>English</u> All students:

- 2 blue or black ink pens
- 2 red pens or felt tip markers
- 2 highlighters (any color)
- 2 pads of 3" x 3" Post-It notes
- Roll white-out (optional)
- 2 packs of 3"x5" lined index cards

### Ms. Mason's students:

- 2 3" hard cover, goodcondition 3-ring binders
- Pencil bag
- 2 #2 pencils with erasers
- 2 spiral notebooks (wide rule)
- Wide-ruled binder paper
- Binder dividers
- 1 box Kleenex (unscented)
- 1 box baby wipes (unscented)
- 1 roll paper towels

- Dictionary that fits in binder, or pocket dictionary (optional)
- Thesaurus (optional)
- Portable art supplies markers, crayons, colored pencils, glue, stapler, scissors, a small ruler, etc. (optional)

- Folders for reports (no slide plastic bars!) (optional)

## <u>Science</u>

- Pencils
- Black or blue pens

- Red pens for correcting
  work
- Colored pencils
- Glue sticks
- 5 packs of 3" x 5" index cards
- A ream of 8½" x 11" lined binder paper (No spiral notebooks, please.)
- Cornell note paper (optional) – available at the Husky Student Store in the fall
- A journal with lined pages (such as a composition book)
- 1 box Kleenex
- Calculator (optional)
- Ruler with metric measurements (optional)
- A separate science section (with multiple dividers) in a multisubject binder, or a separate small binder with dividers

#### <u>STEM</u>

- Ruler with both inches and centimeters
- 2 pencils and a personal mini-sharpener in class each day (with lots of extra pencils at home) or a mechanical pencil with extra refills
- Colored pencils
- USB flash drive

#### <u>Math</u> All students (each day, students must have):

- 2 pencils in class each day (with lots of extras at home) <u>or</u> a mechanical pencil with extra refills
- Erasers

- Pens
- 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 11" binder paper
- A separate math section (divider) in a multisubject binder, or a separate binder

# All students (requested classroom donations):

- 1 ream white printer paper
- 1 box Kleenex

### **Social Studies**

- Black or blue pens (no "clicky pens!")
- Red pens
- College ruled loose leaf paper (8½" x 11" – not 8 x 10½")
- 12" ruler
- Colored pens or pencils
- Stapler (at home)
- A separate social studies section (divider) in a multi-subject binder, or a separate binder
