Welcome to the new school year! We look forward to spending a great year with you!

On the first day of school, students should bring pens, pencils, paper, a backpack, and lunch or lunch money.

Once students receive their schedules, they may receive additional information about requirements from their teachers. In the meantime, we provide the following information and hope it is useful to you. Depending on their schedules, students may not need everything listed below, and some materials not included on this list may be needed.

*In addition to this list, all students are recommended to have an **agenda or planner**. A spiral-bound agenda commonly used by many HM middle school students will be available for purchase in the Husky Student Store when school begins.*

English

- A 3-ring binder
- Loose leaf binder paper
- Pens
- Pencils
- Colored pens for correcting and illustrating
- A high-interest, reading-level appropriate outside reading book

Social Studies

- Black or blue pens (no "clicky pens!")
- Red pens
- College ruled loose leaf paper (8½" x 11" – not 8 x 10½")
- 12" ruler
- Colored pens or pencils
- Stapler (at home)
- A separate social studies section (divider) in a multi-subject binder, or a separate binder

P.E.

- 1 1-1/2" flexible covered binder
- 1 pencil pouch to fit inside 3-ring binder
- 3 dividers
- 2 pencils and 1 eraser
- Reinforcements

Math

All students (each day, students must have):

- 2 pencils in class each day (with lots of extras at home) or a mechanical pencil with extra refills
- Erasers
- Pens
- 8½" x 11" binder paper
- A separate math section (divider) in a multi-subject binder, or a separate binder

All students (requested classroom donations):

- 1 ream white printer paper
- 1 box Kleenex

Science

- Pencils
- Black or blue pens
- Colored pencils
- Red pen for correcting work
- Glue sticks
- Scissors (at home)
- Stapler (at home)
- Tape (at home)
- A ream of 8½" x 11" college ruled loose leaf

paper (No spiral notebooks, please.)

- Cornell note paper (optional) – available at the Husky Student Store in the fall
- 1 box Kleenex
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- Calculator (optional)
- Ruler with metric measurements (optional)
- A separate science section (with multiple dividers) in a multi-subject binder, or a separate small binder with dividers
- Latex free gloves

Spanish (if taken)

- Blue, black and red pens
- Colored pencils
- 2 separate spiral-bound notebooks, each containing 120 sheets of college ruled paper (8½" x 11" – not 8" x 10½")
- 1 dry erase marker (e.g. Expo marker)
- An individual dry erase white board (8½" x 11" or larger, but no larger than 11" x 14")

Information about other middle school requirements (P.E. uniforms, etc.) will be provided once the school year has begun, and students do not need to have them in advance of the first day of school.
