Depending on their schedules, students may not need everything listed below, and some materials not included on this list may be needed.

In addition to this list, all students are recommended to have an **agenda or planner**. A spiral-bound agenda commonly used by many HM middle school students will be available for purchase in the Husky Student Store when school begins.

Information about other middle school requirements (P.E. uniforms, etc.) will be provided once the school year has begun, and students do not need to have them in advance of the first day of school

### <u>Science</u> All students (each day, students must have):

- Pencils
- Blue or black Pens
- Pens for correcting work (not blue or black)
- College ruled loose leaf paper (8½" x 11")
- Graph paper
- Cornell note paper (optional) – available at the Husky Student Store in the fall
- Ruler with metric measurements
- Calculator (scientific, if possible)
- 1 box Kleenex
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- A separate science section (divider) in a multi-subject binder, or a separate binder
- Latex free gloves

## All students (at home, students must have):

- Colored pencils
- Glue sticks
- Scissors

- 3" x 5" lined index cards

- A 3-ring binder
- Loose leaf binder paper
